Red crown and red spotted throat; dark green above, gray below; wide outer tail feathers

Anna's Hummingbird



3-4", Spring, Summer
Fiery-red Throat, green back, rusty sides, rump and tail; narrow outer tail feathers

Allen's Hummingbird



3-4", Spring, Summer
Black throat with purple collar; green above with some green on sides; whitish below

Black-chinned Hummingbird



3-4", Fall, Winter, Spring
Scarlet crown, light eye ring, olive-gray above, white below; white wing bars

Ruby-crowned Kinglet



3-4", Year-round
Gray above with light underparts; small bill, dark eyes

Bushtit



3-4", Spring, Summer
White in breast; violet crown and neck; green back, sides and tail

Costa's Hummingbird



3-4", Year-round
Grayish-brown cap; blue-gray back, creamy white below

Pygmy Nuthatch



4-5", Year-round
Grayish body, jaunty crest, light throat and underparts

Plain Titmouse



4-5", Year-round
Gray-olive above, lighter below; white eye ring broken above eye; white wing bars

Hutton's Vireo



4-5", Year-round
Dark cap and throat; white cheeks, chestnut upper back and sides

Chestnut-backed Chickadee



4-5", Spring, Summer, Fall
White tear drop eye ring, orange lower bill; olive-brown above, yellow below; long tail

Pacific-slope Flycatcher



4-5", Year-round
Dark gray above, brownish-gray below; black cap and tail; narrow white eye ring

Blue-gray Gnatcatcher



4-5", Spring, Summer, Fall
Yellow overall; dark eyes; reddish streaks below; black in wings and yellow tail

Yellow Warbler



4-5", Year-round
Black cap, stubby bill, bright yellow below, white rump, white edges on black wings

American Goldfinch



4-5", Spring, Summer, Fall
Olive above, bright yellow below; yellow face with black cap; longish tail

Wilson's Warbler

4-5", Year-round
Black crown, bright yellow neck and breast; dark above, dark rump, white wing patch at base of primaries

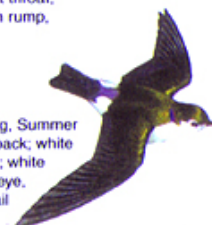
6-7", Spring, Summer, Fall
Rusty-red forehead and throat; metallic-blue back, cinnamon below, long deeply forked tail

Barn Swallow



6-7", Spring, Summer
Buff forehead with chestnut throat; white belly, dark back, tannish rump, unforked squarish tail

Cliff Swallow



6-7", Spring, Summer
Violet-green head and back; white face and underparts; white cheek extends above eye, dark wings and tail

Violet-green Swallow



6-7", Year-round
Conspicuous white eyes; grayish-brown with lightly streaked breast, long tail

Wren



6-7", Year-round
Distinctive white back; red patch on head, small bill; light gray-brown below, spotted on wings

Downy Woodpecker



6-7", Spring, Summer
Olive-brown above; large head with longish bill; whitish throat, belly and rump; streaked sides, short tail

Olive-sided Flycatcher



6-7", Spring, Summer
Black head; thick, rusty-orange collar and breast; light belly, black wings with white tips

Black-headed Grosbeak



6-7", Fall, Winter, Spring
Light brown with pointed crest; red wax-like tips on secondary flight feathers; yellow belly and tail band

Cedar Waxwing



6-7", Year-round
Pale brown-gray above and in throat; dark eyes; cinnamon belly, dark tail

Say's Phoebe



6-7", Year-round
Deep blue hood, rusty breast and back; white belly, long-winged and short-tailed
